

TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD
BEACH PARKING AND USE ORDINANCE
Town Ordinance # 11-01

This ordinance is effective November 14, 2011 indefinitely until revised or cancelled. All previous ordinances applicable to beach parking/use are cancelled. Violation of this ordinance can lead to a warning or, pursuant to RSA 31:39, a penalty of \$25 for each offense.

Users are encouraged to display valid transfer station tags or decals. In the absence of transfer station tags or decals, users may be required to provide proof of eligibility as defined below.

DEFINITIONS

Individuals:

- **Town Resident:** An individual or member of a household domiciled in Springfield on a full-time basis, or those on a part-time basis such as owners or renters of a seasonal dwelling.
- **Non-Resident Property Owner:** An individual or member of an individual's household who is not domiciled in Springfield but holds title to property in the Town. Such property need not have a structure on it.
- **Business Resident:** The proprietor of a business owned or leased in Springfield. The owner need not be domiciled in Springfield.
- **Owners of Inns, Bed and Breakfasts, Hotels and Motels:** owners of a business duly licensed by the State of New Hampshire which accepts overnight guests.
- **Non-Resident Town Employee:** Regular full-time, regular part-time and seasonal employees whose domicile is other than Springfield.
- **Bona Fide Guest:** Overnight or daytime guest(s) of the above categories.

Beach, Picnic and Associated Parking Area: Town-owned property on New Hampshire Route 114/Main Street as depicted in the tax records as map and lot 23-830-460.

BEACH PARKING AND USE

Individuals in all categories above may park on Town property at the beach and use the beach and picnic areas. Individuals not in these categories may be asked to leave by Town Police.

The following restrictions apply to everyone who uses the beach, picnic and parking areas.

- Individual users are responsible for their own safety. No lifeguard is provided.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted.
- No mooring of any type of watercraft is permitted.
- No livestock or pets are allowed.
- No fires are allowed except in barbeque stands provided.

- Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a designated responsible adult.
- Vehicles must be parked perpendicular to the highway and head in.
- Diving is not permitted from the swimming rafts.
- Trash and litter must be disposed of in containers provided.
- Use of the sanitary facility ("porta potty") is mandatory. Children in diapers must wear approved swim diapers.
- Any behavior which is deemed criminal, reckless (RSA 631:3), dangerous or confrontational by law enforcement or any Town official is not permitted.

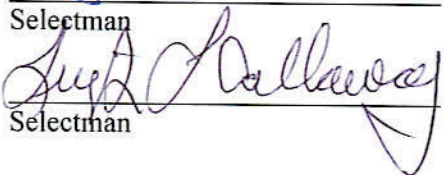
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
