

**Town of Springfield, NH
Cemetery Regulations - 2013**

1. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on premises
2. Refrain from using breakable containers for flowers on gravesites. Cemetery personnel are not responsible for broken items. Glass jars and vases are strictly prohibited.
3. No shrubs, bushes or trees are to be planted on individual lots. Any existing shrubs, bushes or trees intruding on another lot will be removed.
4. All artificial flowers, wreaths and containers will be removed by April 30 and November 1.
5. Winter sledding is not permitted on premises.
6. Lots are to be sold only to residents and taxpayers.
7. Corner markers are mandatory and must be flush with the ground.
8. All markers and stones, except the main monument, must be flush with the ground.
9. Lots in the new addition of the Pleasant View Cemetery are in a grid and are sold individually. They are sold as individual lots.
10. While the town will exercise all possible care to protect the memorial or ornaments on such memorial or other structures, it disclaims responsibility or any damage thereto.
11. Recreational vehicles are prohibited in the cemetery proper. Personal automobiles must keep to designated roadways, except in the case of handicapped or elderly visitors who wish to visit family gravesites.
