You are hereby notified that the appeal of Audrius Kazenas on behalf of the property owner, Sue-Ann Connary, for a Special Exception to operate a dog Kennel, has been **DENIED** by the affirmative vote of five members of the Board, as the appeal failed to meet all of the criteria required as defined in Section XI, 11:42 of the Zoning Ordinance most specifically (but not necessarily limited to) "E" which requires "operation in connection with such a use shall not be more objectionable to nearby properties by reason of noise, fumes, odor, or vibration, than would be the operation of any permitted uses in this District which are not subject to special exception procedures."
