**Town Lots:**

Bruce Allen indicated that he had spoken with Janet Roberts and clarified questions about the Knowlton and Fogg lots. It was noted that we should repaint the blazes along the property line of the Knowlton lot as they are becoming difficult to see.

**250<sup>th</sup> Celebration:**

The Collins Park lot is being surveyed to clarify corners and property lines. Once the survey is completed, the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary committee will discuss possible projects involving Collins Park. Abutting land owners will be kept apprised of these discussions.

**Goals for the Year:**

A proposed loop trail on the back (power line) side of the Kinsley lot has been flagged by Marla Binzel, Cynthia Bruss and Daphne Klein. Commission members will be finalizing the route and clearing brush in the upcoming months. When a second trail originating on the Cemetery Rd side of the lot is developed, it was noted that it would be beneficial to get permission from the owner of the land on the corner of the Kinsley lot to enable a short section of the trail to pass across his land.

**Zoning, Planning and Selectmen Report:**

Dick Hendl reported that he has been in contact with Jeff Blecharczyk, the Compliance Supervisor with Land Resource Management within DES about the potential violation of the Shoreland Water Quality Protection Act along Lake Kolelemook. He will keep the Commission updated on any further developments.
