Pages 39 through 54 of the Plan were reviewed and updates recommended.

Hazard Risk, Critical Facilities, and Mitigation Action, were reviewed and rated. The action plan implementation scheduled was reviewed. The vulnerability of existing developed areas were assessed for Dam Failure, Flooding, Hurricane, Tornado & Downburst, Thunderstorm/Lightening/Hail, Severe Weather, Earthquake, Landslide, Drought, Extreme Heat/Cold, Erosion, Wildfire, Natural Air & Water Contaminants, HazMat Spills, Biohazard, Terrorism, Active Shooter, and Opioid Crisis were all rated to determine cost and impact to health, welfare, and property damages.

Emergency facilities were identified.

Meghan hopes to have the plan pretty much “wrapped-up” by the next meeting. She will be in touch with individual parties as necessary to complete the process. Goal for submission to the State is May 2018.
